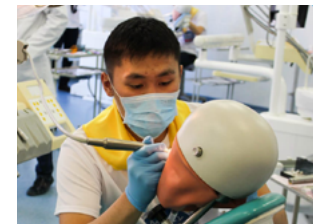

We invite you on our Preparatory Department which is open to all international students preparing for graduate study at MSMSU. Students have the opportunity to learn Russian and other disciplines.

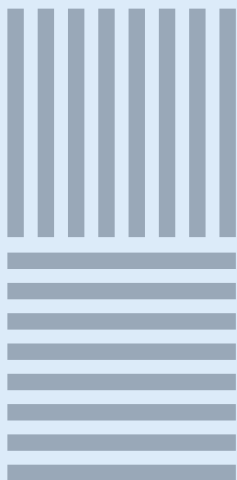


BASIC TRAINING COURSE

**The basic training course lasts 11 months, from October to August.
 Russian as a Foreign Language, Biology, Chemistry**

Foreign citizens studying at the Preparatory Department are granted the right to reside in the Russian Federation or they can study remotely.

11 - MONTH PROGRAM RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (TORFL-I / B1)



Training period:
from October 1, 2022 to August 31, 2023

Classes are held **4 times a week** in the first semester and **5 times a week** in the second semester.
Lesson duration – **6 academic hours**.

At the end of the training session the test and the **final examination** are held. The **diploma** is given to a graduate of the preparatory department based on the results of the final examination.

Classroom load:
Russian as a foreign language from scratch – **732 acad. hours**,
Chemistry, Biology – **156 acad. hours**



The purpose of the program:
the study of Russian as a foreign language, Biology and Chemistry for admission to the Medical University.

Target audience:
foreigners who do not speak Russian, willing to enter Russian Medical University.

RUSSIAN



Russian as a foreign language

1.10.2022-31.08.2023

The Russian language course is conducted in Russian. The course is based on the best manuals published by the leading universities in Russia, moreover, they include online resources necessary for enriching vocabulary, practicing grammar and developing listening, reading, writing and speaking skills.





RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (0-A1-A1.1-A1.2 LEVEL)

Course objectives:

- to learn the Russian alphabet;
- to develop pronunciation skills;
- to obtain a knowledge of elementary Russian grammar;
- to be able to speak about yourself, family, friends, work and studies, free time, hometown, weather etc.;
- to ask questions and hold a short conversation;
- to write simple texts on such topics as yourself, family, study at University, friends, work and free time;
- to get an insight and understanding of Russian culture.

RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (A2.1-A2.2 LEVEL)

Course objectives:

- to develop pronunciation skills;
- to improve the knowledge of elementary Russian grammar;
- to be able to speak about yourself, family, friends, work and study at University, free time, hometown, weather etc.;
- to understand a basic conversation as well as elementary authentic texts and adapted texts in Russian;
- to ask questions and hold a short conversation;
- to write texts such as letters on different topics;
- to get an insight and understanding of Russian culture.

RUSSIAN AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (B1.1-B1.2 LEVEL)

Course objectives:

- to develop pronunciation skills;
- to obtain knowledge of an intermediate level of Russian grammar;
- to be able to speak about yourself, your interests, family, work, studies, free time, health, hometown etc.;
- to be able to ask questions and hold a conversation, thus communicating effectively in different everyday situations;
- to understand an authentic conversation or text in Russian as well as some details and the writer's conclusion;
- to understand texts on various topics and speak about them, in addition to expressing individual opinions on a certain topic;
- to write texts of different formats about a range of topics such as yourself, your interests, family, work, studies, free time, health etc.;
- to get an insight and understanding of Russian culture; to prepare for the First Certification Level (TORFL-I / B1) exam.



CHEMISTRY



Chemistry
(6 academic hours)
16.12.2022-30.06.2023

Classes begin in December and are taught in Russian. The course is based on the basic school level of knowledge of chemistry.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

- set up basic concepts of chemistry;
- familiarize students with the most common elements and compounds and their reactivity.

PROGRAM:

- symbols, valences, chemical formulation, nomenclature;
- laws of quantitative, weight and volume chemistry;
- notion of moles;
- periodic properties; table by Mendeleev;
- molecules; chemical bonds (acid, base, oxidant, reducing agent);
- applications of these various foundations of chemistry, in all areas of chemistry: oxidation-reduction, acid-base, etc.





BIOLOGY



Biology
(6 academic hours)
16.12.2022-30.06.2023

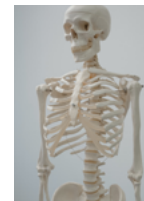
Classes begin in December and are taught in Russian. The course is based on knowledge of the basic school level of biology.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

- to acquire a sense of complexity, of the temporal dimension and of progress, both of biological phenomena and of the knowledge we have of them;
- highlight the varying degrees of probability of assertions;
- to enable students to perceive the links between theory and experimental experience;
- familiarize students with the use of various nomenclature, terminology and symbols.

PROGRAM:


- biochemistry (carbohydrates, lipids, proteins, nucleic acids);
- cytology: cell structure and cell division (mitosis and meiosis);
- genetics: (history, transmission and use); Mendel's laws; population genetics (Hardy-Weinberg law); multifactorial heredity;
- botany;
- zoology;
- human anatomy;
- evolution;
- ecology.



ENROLMENT

Enrolment in the Preparatory Department of MSMSU
(for students residing abroad and requiring a Study Visa)

APPLICATION GUIDE

- 1 fill in the Application form and scan it. Scan QR-code 
- 2 scan your passport or your identity card with its notarised Russian translation;
- 3 scan your diploma or other qualification certificate translated into Russian, legalized or with Apostille;
- 4 send all the scanned documents (the application form, the passport together with its notarised Russian translation, the diploma or other qualification certificate translated into Russian with its notarised Russian translation) by e-mail: prepdep@msmsu.ru, kalutskihan@mail.ru (till August 10);
- 5 wait for the confirmation of the University to enroll the applicant at the Preparatory Department;
- 6 receive the invitation to Russia from the University for document submission and contracting (till September 15);
- 7 arrive in Moscow, come to MSMSU Admissions Office and file all the documents to be enrolled to the Preparatory Department;
- 8 sign the contract.

Cost of training in 2022 is 250.000 RUB

The deadline for the submission of the applications is
the 10 of August 2022.

Start of the course: **01.10.2022**

5. medical certificate (if you study in person in Russia);
6. medical insurance policy (if you study in person in Russia).

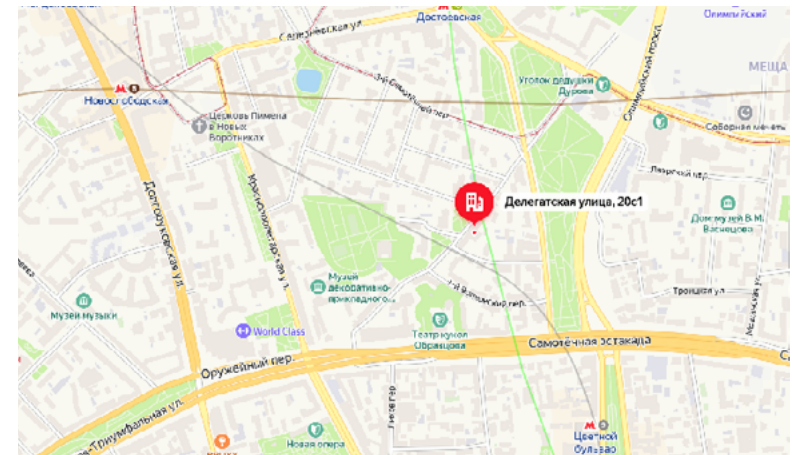
